Chipping Warden relief road and site compound

What are we doing?

As part of HS2's works, our contractor Dawnus will be setting up a compound for works taking place ahead of the construction of the Chipping Warden Relief Road, subject to the relevant consents. This is ahead of the main construction works to build the railway. The road has been designed to improve road safety and reduce traffic within the village.

In order to prepare the site we will need to carry out several activities including: creating a site compound, clearing vegetation, and putting up fencing. Other construction activities will follow, and are expected to last until Spring 2019. We will keep you up to date on these works as they progress.

Site Compound and Construction

The compound will act as a local hub for the construction works in the area and provide;

- Office and welfare facilities for the contractor.
- Storage of materials and equipment to be distributed on to sites in the area.
- Car parking for workers.

We will start work in August and the compound will be operational for approximately 9 months. There will be short periods of traffic management as the access to the compound, off the A361, is improved. The attached map shows the location of the site entrance.

All the buildings on the site will be temporary and the site will have safety fencing and 24hr security during the duration of its use.

There will be a number of HGV visits to site during the construction stage. Once the site is set up it will mainly be 4x4 vehicles with trailers or light agricultural vehicles coming and going as operatives and materials are taken out to the locations we are working on as required. Some activities will require larger lorries delivering materials over a shorter period. Deliveries are expected throughout the winter.

Duration of work

- Normal working hours:
Weekdays - 8am to 6pm
Saturdays - 8am to 1pm
- Our contractors may be on site for one hour's quiet start-up and shutdown outside of these times.

What to expect

- Temporary traffic lights controlling traffic in each direction during site access improvements.
- Small numbers of HGVs and other traffic movements. These will use only agreed routes.

What we will do

- Manage any impacts, such as traffic delays and noise with the aim of reducing or removing them.
- Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.
- Inform you of any changes to the dates we have given you.
- Take care to respect your community and the environment.



How may this affect me?

You may notice some additional traffic on the roads immediately around the welfare and storage site. Where possible HGV visits to site will be made out of peak times.

While works are being undertaken to improve access to the compound site we may need temporary traffic management. We will undertake as much of this work outside of peak hours as possible.

We will be taking measures to reduce as much noise and vibration as possible on any powered machinery.

Work is only planned to take place between 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday. It is unlikely we will need to work on a Saturday, but if we do, this will only be between 8am to 1pm. We may work for an additional hour either side of these times for set up and shut down.

Duration of work

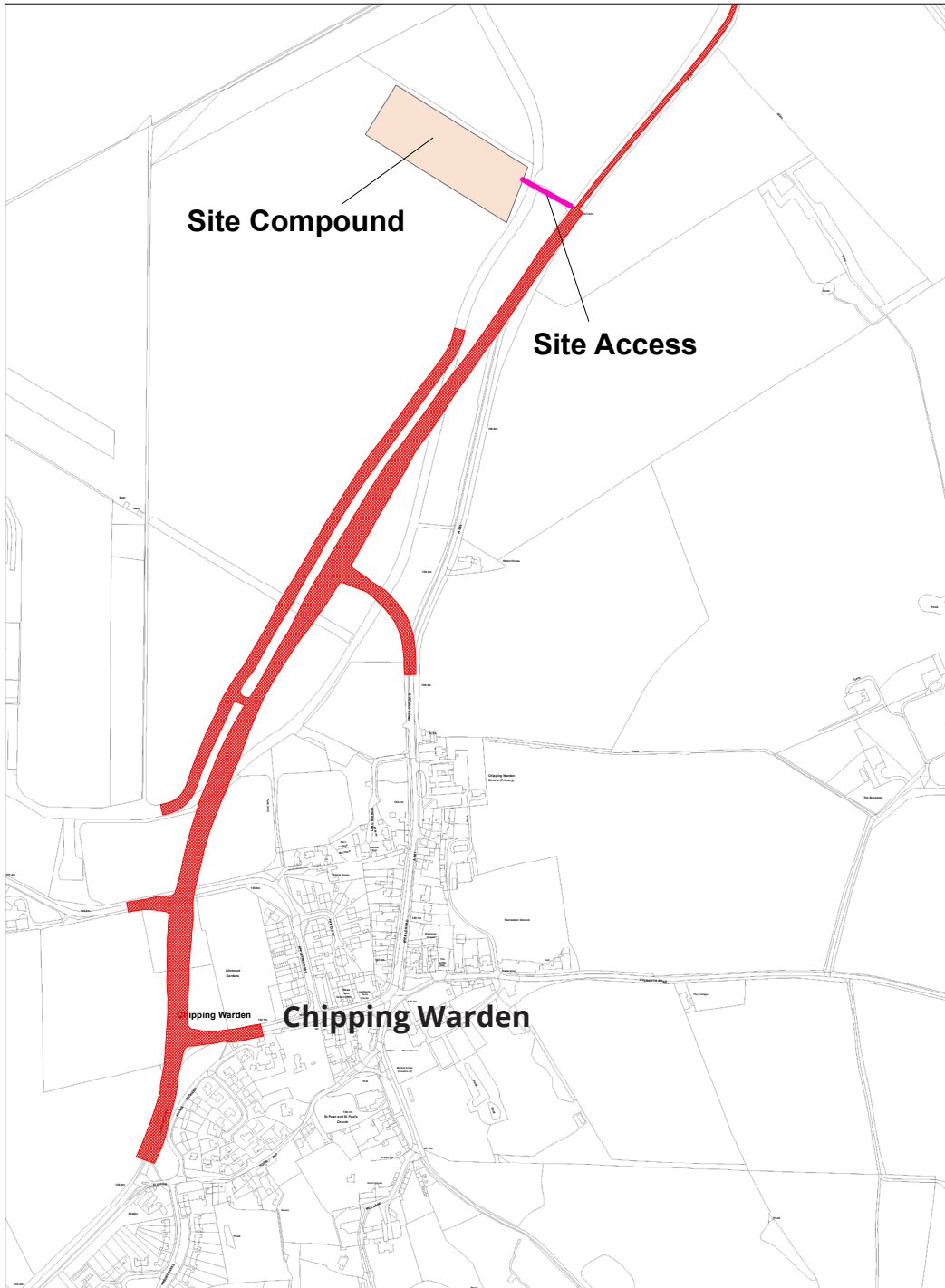
- Normal working hours:
