- 80.1 **Open Forum** – Several residents were present who raised the issue of the possible Playground development. After discussion it was agreed that they should take forward a bid to Hs2 CEF for funding to improve facilities in existing play area. They will report back to PC with updates. PC offered full support.

It is now very unlikely that Culworth Road will remain open.
