88.7	<b>HS2</b>	Schedule of road closures on A361 for tie-ins at either end of relief road will be checked but it would appear that dates are 24th-27th Jan, 31st Jan-3rd Feb, 7th-10th Feb and 14th-17 Feb. Dates for northern tie-in are not yet confirmed. Stagecoach have written to say that there may be no service – this is under investigation. Discussion took place concerning work at Trafford Bridge re viaduct and proposed bridge for farm access. Request made for road sweeper to clean Culworth Road by t-junction with Welsh Lane. Extra vehicles using this section due to closure of Welsh Lane/A361; this will brought up at next Hs2 meeting. A committee of MPs has been started to discuss the future of Hs2 lead by Banbury MP, Victoria Prentice. A letter from CWPC will be sent outlining our ongoing concerns. Occupiers of Blackgrounds Farm have been given notice to leave and archaeological investigations will take about a year.			NG NG  NG NG
