High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As we reintroduce face to face engagement, which is in addition to the ongoing virtual engagement, we will continue to follow government guidance on reducing the spread of Covid-19. The health and safety of our workforce and the communities we work within is our priority. What are we doing?

In October 2022, we will be carrying out topographical surveys of Culworth Road. These surveys will help us to finalise the design of the new railway.

A topographical survey is an exercise undertaken by land surveyors using highly specialised survey equipment. These surveys provide detailed maps of land, identifying both natural and man-made features within a specified area.

To carry out these surveys safely and effectively, we will need to put in place a road closure with signed diversions. This is for reasons of safety, as our staff will be working directly in the carriageway.

When will these works take place?

A section of Culworth Road will be closed between 8am and 6pm on Wednesday 5 October to Friday 7 October 2022.

Access for residents will be maintained within the closure area of Culworth Road.

Duration of works

Works will commence

Culworth Road will be closed, during the day, from Wednesday 5 October to Friday 7 October 2022.

Normal working hours:

Monday to Friday

8.00am – 6.00pm

Saturdays

8.00am – 1.00pm

Works will be carried out within normal working hours, however some additional evening or weekend working may be required when necessary.

What to expect

Daytime road closures of Culworth Road for topographical surveys.

Varied activities with both quiet and busier periods.

What we will do

Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.

Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.

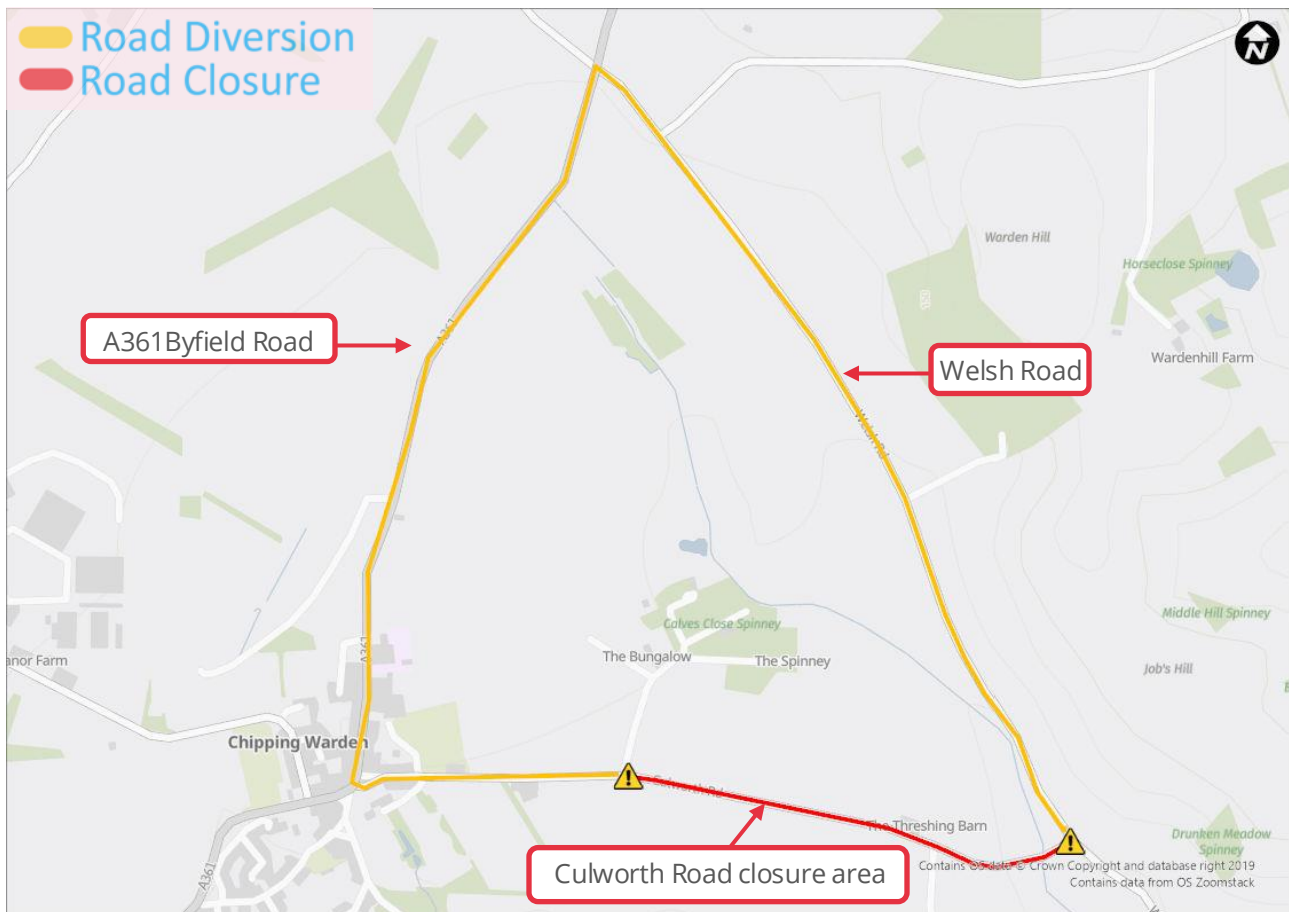

The map below, shows the closure on Culworth Road and the local diversion route. Access for residents in the closure area will be maintained.
