- 4. Liaison meeting are a good place to discuss & negotiate many local issues.
- 5. Mrs Eastwood said that HS2 still have ownership of the relief road & it has not been handed over to WNS.
- It may be possible to organise a meeting with Gary Pettifer with Parish Council to discuss many of these 6. issues.
